



Discussion / Decisions

- 1 Shri Arun Kumar from CIL suggested the following
 - College should reach out to companies like TCS, HCL, Tech-Mahindra in MIHAN for more interaction and leverage proximity – Action TPO.
 - College may arrange a one day workshop for project management tools for training faculties. He will suggest a resource person for PM tools.
 - To prepare proposal mentioning the utility of FMS lab and to find which components can be designed and how will it be useful to students and industry.
 - Course end survey should be analysed. Online survey may be introduced. College may look for ERP to get intelligent output out of analysis.
 - MOOCs can be employed for teaching difficult subjects
 - He appreciated look and content of the CCoEW Website and suggested that SEO may be taken up for preferential search.
- 2 Shri. Sudhakar Kunte suggested finding out different methods to improve marks of students in university exams. He also told to find out what is the use of FMS lab to industries in nearby locality.
- 3 Shri Milind Kukde suggested HoDs of ETC and Mechanical to approach HVDC Chandrapur, Koradi Themal Power Plant and IEPL for Internship. HoDs to facilitate students should register before March at HVDC for internship.
- 4 Principal sir suggested following
 - He expressed major concern over low class average in all the results and suggested that all



faculties should ensure proper T/L process as per given SoP for tutorials.

- All faculties of ETC to visit more than 100 Electronics MSMEs that exist in Nagpur and develop a rapport with all of them.
- He said that departments should take efforts for internship of their students. T&P department will only further facilitate and keep records.
- He suggested all HoDs to ensure that the teaching and practical periods are completed in time so that students can go for ED activity on time. This was to ensure timely departure of buses from campus.
- He requested ETC faculties to meet him for discussion on result of their department and to plan future activities to improve class average.
- He also asked the HoDs to increase the standard of questions being asked in the college exams.
- He directed Prf. Kedar Chimote to prepare a proposal for FMS lab and meet industry personal from BMA and MIDC to look for their requirement and prospective use by them.
- The discussion was done on CO_PO attainment sheet preparation and on target levels and the weightages for IE. These were frozen after discussion.
 - It was decided that from this semester onwards Sessional 1 and sessional 2 will be conducted instead of MTT and PUT to ensure proper and equal weightage is given for all CO in the IE. Sessional 1 shall have first 2/3 units from syllabus and sessional 2 shall be based on rest of them keeping exam pattern same.
 - Ms. Akshita Prasad suggested conducting more tests in a semester and quizzes on some topics.
- 6 As there were no more points for discussion, meeting was concluded with thanks to Chair and Lunch for all.

- Principal suggested that there should be PTM after every exam on the same day of the display of the result.
- Our college is hosting IEEE event "Ignite" on 28th and 29 Aug 19, informed Principal. All faculties should work for that. Nearly 300 students are expected to attend the program. There will be 15 to 20 lectures and eminent persons from industry will be called for conducting sessions. There will be competitions, expo panel discussions etc
- 3 Principal instructed to upload the Academic calendar on the website.
- 4 Sakhi mdam informed that the new lab will be ready by 15 June
- 5 Every class teacher will be responsible for proper shut down of projectors in the class rooms said Principal sir
- 6 Department wise load distribution was discussed in the meeting, Principal asked HoD ETC to discuss their load separately with principal.
- Prof AB informed principal that they will take add on courses on IOT and Python for third year and final year and basics for second year students. Mech department has planned Engine tear down for final year, Lathe for second year and compression for 3rd year informed HOD. Prof Sakhi told principal that there will be Android, php and ML and DBMS workshops planned by the department. Principal asked each HOD to send a detailed schedule of skill development plan to him. They should also submit the detailed report of the program after execution.
- 8 Principal suggested to include report writing, office tools, literature survey, shortcuts for MS office in the skill development program.
- Yoga should be planned every day for all students during skill development week and all HoDs should send their students for that. International Yoga day should be coordinated by Mech dept ,directed principal sir
- 10 Engineers day should be coordinated by CE dept, Cultural head should be from ETC dept, and the new cultural head should coordinate 15th Aug ,election, Dahihandi ,Garba etc for the coming year.
- 11 Those who have done Agile workshop should take a training session for all faculties in the college suggested principal sir.
- 12 There is a serious concern about the usage of library. It is observed that very few faculties and students use /visit library. They do not read the journals or books. Each department should make a list of journals for their department and they should conduct a seminar in which each faculty will share at least one paper from a journal on every Saturday. Every faculty should write about the paper/ book read by them in the monthly report.
- 13 Principal informed that there will be a program for signing of MOU in the city in the last week of June. There are 5 MOUs to be signed.
 - 1). Dnyan Foundation, 2)FABLAB, 3)TCS, 4)ISSAC and 5)UNDP. All coordinators for that should come together to work for the program.
