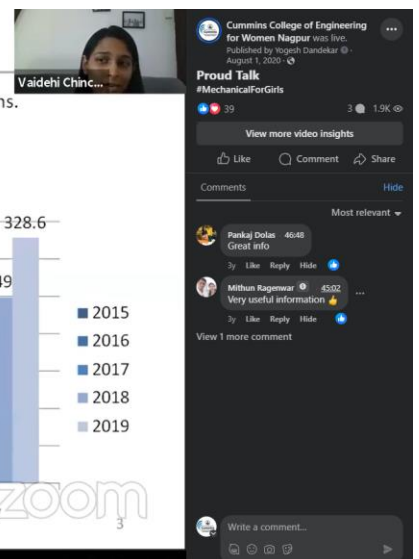


Global Scenario

- It recorded 60% annual average increase over last five years.



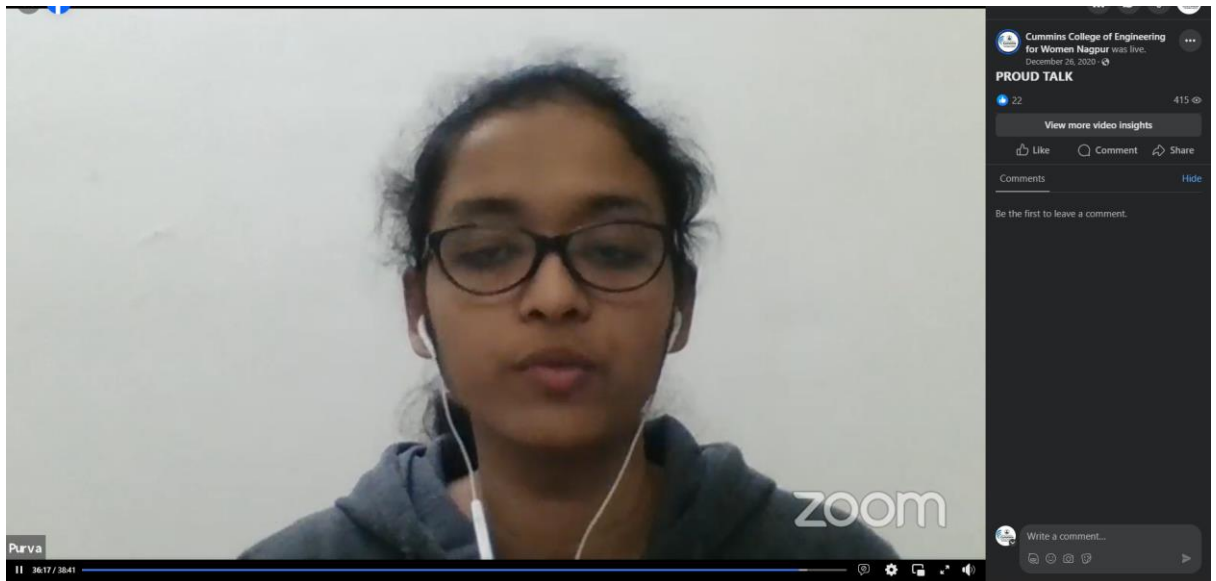

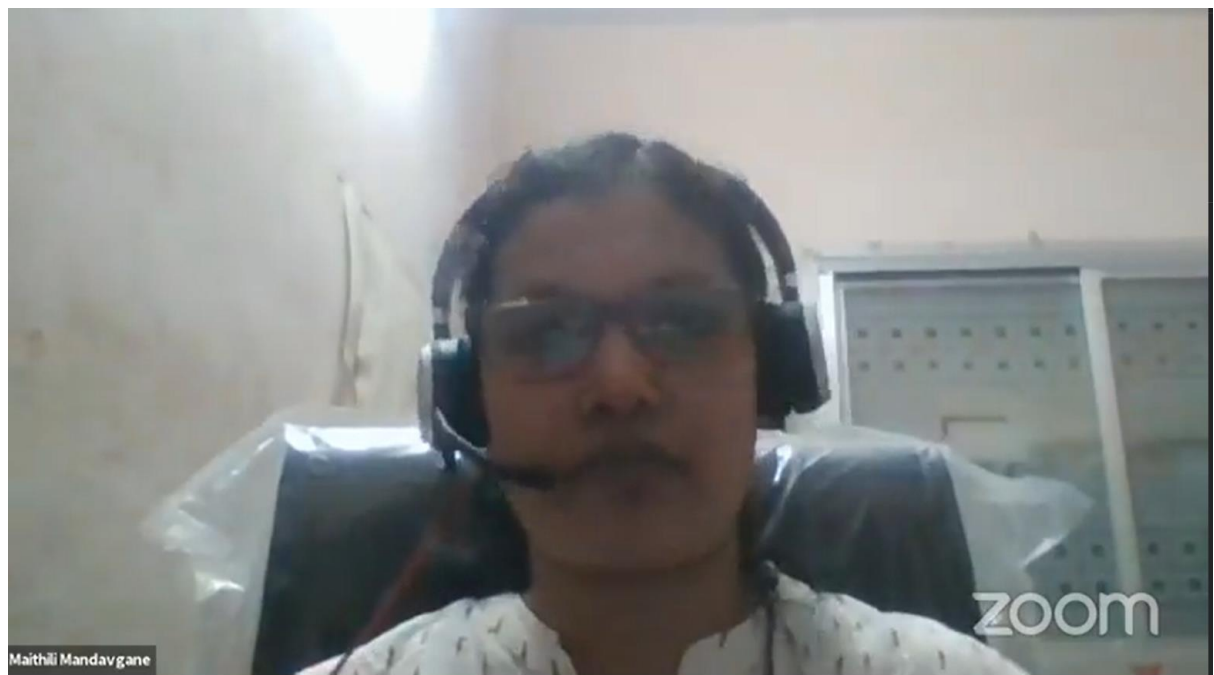
